- Review Parking Committee Purpose:
 - **Parking Committee Purpose:** To Create a Parking Management Plan for the implementation of paid parking to generate revenue for the City that uses innovative strategies to accommodate seasonal parking demands.
 - Understanding that the committee was formed to create solutions to long term parking.
 - Can evolve to more, but Mayor Ringberg would like to focus on paid parking right now to generate revenue that will allow the City to do more with parking in the future.
 - Basina not in favor of paid parking. Discussion ensued. **Mayor Ringberg made a motion to approve the parking committee purpose and send forward, with other information, to City Council for their review and approval.** Discussion ensued. No second. Motion dies.
 - **Mayor Ringberg made a motion for the committee to approve the purpose so discussions can continue and eventually send something to Council for their review and approval. Carrier seconded.** Eades expressed concerns of the Chairman seconding the motion. Discussion ensued. What are the procedures if it doesn't pass? What happens to the committee? Fangman would like to see council and public input before moving forward—could change scope of the committee. "Purpose not clearly stated before getting on committee" Discussion ensued. Here as a committee to put together the best scenario of how a paid parking plan should be done for other committees and council to review and implement. Difficult to ask people if a plan is not made. Do we need to be detailed when presenting to the public or simpler? **Mayor Ringberg motioned to call the question. Basina seconded. Ringberg-yes, Carrier-no, Basina-yes, Bodin-yes, Zawislak-yes, Albrecht-yes, Fangman-yes, Kovachevich-yes, Eades-no. Motion carries.** Roll call vote on primary motion: **Ringberg-no, Carrier-no, Basina-no, Bodin-no, Zawislak-no, Albrecht-no, Fangman-no, Kovachevich-no, Eades-no. Motion Fails.**
 - **Eades motioned to ask Council for a purpose and have the committee meet again after the Council determines a purpose for the committee. A starting point can be the purpose presented. Seconded by Basina.** Discussion ensued. **Ringberg-yes, Carrier-yes, Basina-yes, Bodin-no, Zawislak-yes, Albrecht-yes, Fangman-yes, Kovachevich-yes, Eades-yes. Motion Carries.**
