Purpose: To view and pick stone for the City of Bayfield's Wayfinding signage.

Overall Commissioners were pleased at the amount, sizes, and shapes of the brownstone available.

A few measurements were taken:

Large Flat Stone: 7 ½'x5'x2'

Tomb Stone: 6' x 3 ½'

There were various rectangular stones that appeared to be good fits for the Parking Signs. One measured 4'x22"x16".

There are plenty of stones. Need assistance on determining the actual configurations of the stones for the entry signs. Verbally, it was felt the metal signage on the entry signs was preferred over the etched stone option.

Commissioners expressed the need for further assistance in how to pick the stone and lay them out for the entry signs. Might there be someone like a landscape architect who could assist?

The PWD mentioned:

- Innovative masonry – They did the pillar project at the Library
- Building Restoration Corporation – They did the tuck-pointing work at the Courthouse
