### *A Resolution for Budget Adoption and Tax Levy*

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council is appropriating the necessary funds for the operation of the government and administration of the City of Bayfield for the year 2022, and;

**WHEREAS**, there is hereby appropriated out of the receipts of the City of Bayfield for the year 2022, including moneys received from the general property tax levy, to the various purposes specified in the budget publication notice attached as Exhibit "A", and;


**WHEREAS**, the Council is adopting the 2022 Budget as attached as Exhibit "B", and furthermore clarifies their intent to approve each department's total budget rather than line-by-line totals.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, there is hereby levied a tax of \$694,731.24, which includes General Obligation Debt in the amount of \$80,289.24 on all taxable property within the City of Bayfield as returned by the assessor in the year 2021, for the uses and purposes set forth in the budget, and;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to spread this tax on the current tax roll of the City of Bayfield.
